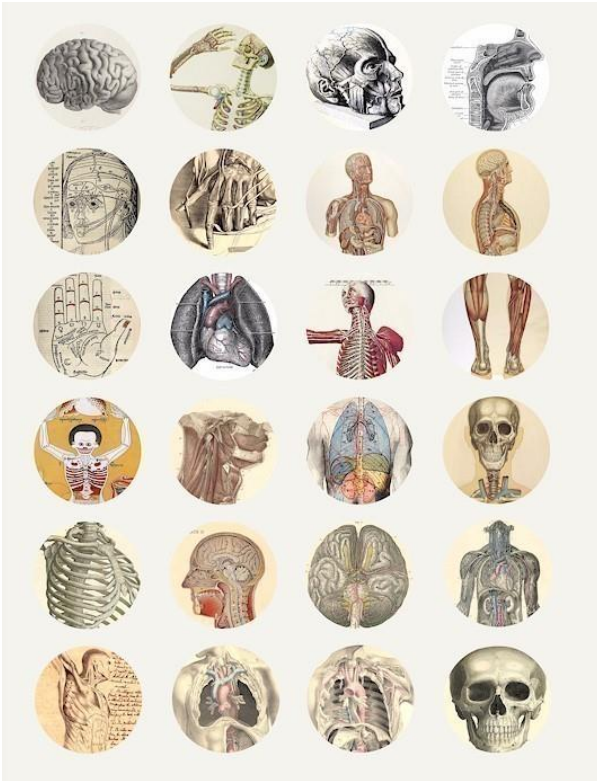


SOUTH VIEW ANATOMY COURSE OUTLINE

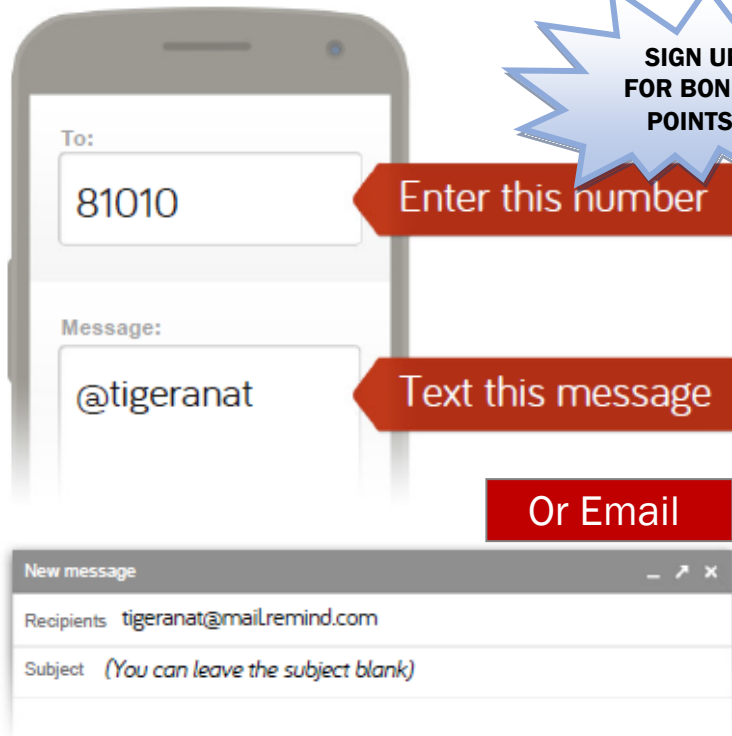
