

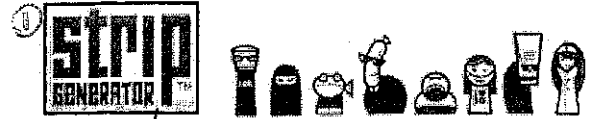
# INTEGUMENT DISORDER/DISEASE COMIC STRIP

## STEP-by-STEP ~ CREATE A COMIC STRIP



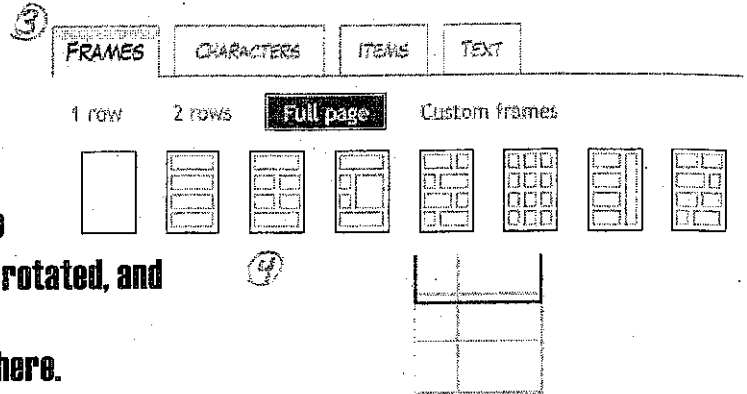
1. Goto: [WWW.STRIPGENERATOR.COM](http://WWW.STRIPGENERATOR.COM)



2. CLICK "CREATE NEW STRIP" AT RIGHT

3. CLICK "FRAMES" Tab, then FULL PAGE  
Choose a Frame Layout with at least 6 frames & Apply

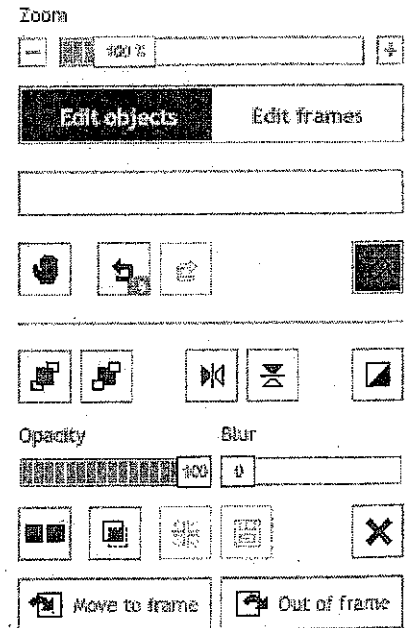
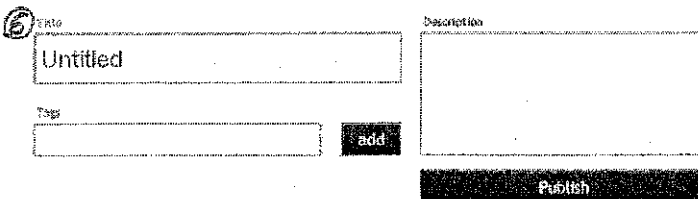


4. Click Tabs at top to Add Characters/Items/Text to each frame to create a story. These can be enlarged, rotated, and moved front to back in the TOOLS area at right. The FIRST FRAME must have YOUR NAME typed somewhere.

5. When you are Done, Click FINISH.



6. Enter a TITLE & Click PUBLISH BUTTON



7. At the bottom of the page that appears after publishing, Select & Copy the DIRECT IMAGE LINK.

The Vampires disease or **Porphyria** which is its scientific term is a set of genetic disorders in which an important part of hemoglobin called heme is not made properly which means there is malfunction of the hemoglobin production. People suffering from it face symptoms manifested by mythological vampires. Their skin is sensitive to sunlight, their urine is reddish to purplish in color, the gums are shrunk making the teeth look more prominent and canine-like and they have an adverse reaction to garlic.

**Seborrhea** is an inflammatory skin disorder affecting the scalp, face, and torso. Typically, seborrheic dermatitis presents with scaly, flaky, itchy, and red skin. It particularly affects the sebaceous-gland-rich areas of skin. In adolescents and adults, seborrheic dermatitis usually presents as scalp scaling similar to dandruff or as mild to marked erythema of the nasolabial fold.

**Alopecia** is a disease that affects the hair follicles, which are part of the skin from which hairs grow. In most cases, hair falls out in small, round patches about the size of a quarter. Many people with the disease get only a few bare patches. Some people may lose more hair. Rarely, the disease causes total loss of hair on the head or complete loss of hair on the head, face, and body.

**Argyria** is a condition caused by inappropriate exposure to chemical compounds of the element silver, or to silver dust. The most dramatic symptom of argyria is that the skin turns blue or bluish-grey. It may take the form of generalized argyria or local argyria. Generalized argyria affects large areas over much of the visible surface of the body. Local argyria shows in limited regions of the body, such as patches of skin, parts of the mucous membrane or the conjunctiva.
